
Excerpt from Coal Mine survey - 2014

The presence of cattle in Site M1 was again having an obvious impacting both on the banks/riparian zone and the river bed as well as significantly adding to the nutrient loads in the water. The banks were damaged and degraded with cattle tracks which are particularly noticeable in Photo 1. The surface of the pool and riffle beds contained large amounts of fine particulate matter from the cattle defecating in the stream.




